#### DIRECTIONS TO UMDNJ'S STRATFORD CAMPUS

**From the North:** • Take the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 4 to Route 73 North to Route 295 South. • Follow Route 295 South to Exit 29. Turn left onto access road to Route 30. At light turn left onto Route 30 East (White Horse Pike). • Follow directions from Route 30 below. **From the South:** • Follow Route 295 North to Exit 29A to Route 30. • Follow directions from Route 30 below. **From Route 30:** • Follow Route 30 East (and the blue hospital signs) for 3.3 miles to the traffic light at Laurel Road. • Turn right onto Laurel Road. Take the first left into the UMDNJ Stratford Campus and continue straight into patient/visitor parking. Go to Academic Center.
